7. What charge did the scribes and Pharisees level against Jesus when they saw Him dining in a tax collector’s house? What was Jesus’ answer?
8. What did Jesus answer when asked why His disciples did not fast?
9. What were the disciples of Jesus doing on the Sabbath as they passed through grainfields? What did the Pharisees think they were doing by this act? What was Jesus’ response?
10. How did Jesus refer to Himself in verses ten and twenty-eight?
