2. Describe Job's family (Job. 1:2)
3. Describe Job's wealth. (Job 1:3)
4. Describe the religious life of Job. (Job 1:5)
5. What was the challenge that Satan put before Jehovah concerning Job? (1:6-12)
6. What did Satan do to Job? (1:13-22) How did Job endure?
7. What was the second challenge that Satan put to Jehovah concerning Job? (2:1-6)
8. What did Satan do to Job next? (2:7-13) Who did he employ to assist him?
9. How did Job behave in the midst of his trial? (Job 1:22, 42:1-6)
10. How did the Lord bless Job after his trials? (Job 42:12) How is this significant?

2. Describe Job with respect to his character (see: Job 29-31)
3. What does Job say about some issues of our day, namely, abortion, suicide and origins?
