5. How was it possible for Levi to pay tithes to Melchizedek? (Hebrews 7:8-10)
6. What conclusion does the Hebrew writer draw from this? (Hebrews 7:12)
7. Why does the Hebrew writer say that Melchizedek continues to live? (Hebrews 7:8)
8. How was Melchizedek made like unto the Son of God? (Hebrews 7:3)
9. Which is the superior priesthood, the order of Levi or the order of Melchizedek?
10. Of whom is David speaking in Psalm 110:4? (see: Matthew 22:41-46)

1. Is Melchizedek an Old Testament manifestation of the Word of God? (Hebrews 7:3)
2. Compare and contrast the priesthood's of Levi and Melchizedek.
3. As a type of Christ, what is the significance of Melchizedek being both a priest and king?
