The Kingdom of God

I. In Government, God's Church is a Kingdom:

- A. Kingdom preached at hand (Matt. 3:2; Mark 1:14-15).
- B. Parables set forth Church as Kingdom (Matt. 13:24, 44, 45, 47).
- C. Apostles given authority in Kingdom (Matt. 16:18-19; 19:28).
- D. People alive in time of Christ were to witness coming of Kingdom (Mark 9:1; Luke 9:27; 12:31-32).
- E. A spiritual Kingdom—not earthly (John 18:36; Rom. 14: 17; 1 Cor. 4:20; Luke 17:20-21).
- F. After day of Pentecost and coming of Holy Spirit, Kingdom spoken of as in existence (Acts 8:12; 20:25; 28:23, 31; Col. 1:13; 1 Thess. 2:12).
- G. In coming unto the Church, we receive the Kingdom (Heb. 12:22-28).
- H. Lord's Supper is in the Kingdom (Luke 22:16-18; 29-30).

II. Christ as King:

- A. By His own teaching and acknowledgment (Luke 23:1-3; John 18:37).
- B. He conquered in becoming King (Heb. 2:9, 14-15; Rev. 1:18; 1 John 3:8; Matt. 12:24-29; Luke 11:17-22; 10:17-19).
- C. His territory (Luke 4:5-8) was wrested from Satan (Matt. 28:18-20; Rev. 1:5-9).
- D. His authority and throne (Luke 1:32-33; Eph. 1:18-23; 1 Tim. 6:15; 1 Pet. 3:22).
- E. His law (John 12:48; 1:17; 17:8; 1 Cor. 9:21; 1 John 4:6).

III. Essentials of Citizenship in God's Kingdom:

- A. Enter by new birth (John 3:5; Acts 2:36-41).
- B. Must do God's will (Matt. 7:21).
- C. Center affections on heavenly things (Phil. 3:12-15; Col. 3:1-4).
- E. Greatness in Kingdom measured by service rendered (Matt. 20:20-28).
- F. Must be united (Luke 11:17).
- G. Requires sacrifice (Mark 10:23-31).
- H. Receive as little child (Mark 10:15).
