What was done by Jesus for all of world - Philippians 2:5-9 5 Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus,[a] 6 who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped,[b] 7 but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant,[c] being born in the likeness of men.

8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

<u>Jesus did a lot of living – Luke 3:23</u> Jesus, when he began his ministry, was about thirty years of age, being the son (as was supposed) of Joseph, the son of Heli,

<u>Jesus Christ at birth is poor - Luke 2:22-24</u> 22 And when the time came for their purification according to the Law of Moses, they brought him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord 23 (as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "Every male who first opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord") 24 and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the Law of the Lord, "a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons." CF Leviticus 12:6-8

<u>Jesus Christ at 12 years old - Luke 2:51-52</u> 51 And he went down with them and came to Nazareth and was submissive to them. And his mother treasured up all these things in her heart. 52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature[a] and in favor with God and man.

<u>Jesus Christ living as a carpenter to about 30 years old - Mark 6:3(cf Matt 13:55</u>, 3 Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? And are not his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him.

<u>Jesus Christ tempted like we are. Hebrews 4:15-16</u>. 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

<u>Jesus Christ would depend on others – Luke 8:2-3 -</u> others "who provided for them[a] out of their means."


<u>Jesus Christ's hometown rejection.</u> – <u>Luke 4:22b</u> "Is not this Joseph's son?" ... <u>28-30</u> Luke 4:28 When they heard these things, all in the synagogue were filled with wrath. 29 And they rose up and drove him out of the town and brought him to the brow of the hill on which their town was built, so that they could throw him down the cliff. 30 But passing through their midst, he went away.

<u>Jesus Christ gave us what we need - John 20:30-31</u> Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

<u>Jesus Christ walked a lot.</u> How many miles did Jesus travel in the ministry? We can follow the list of places in a chronological order to get an estimate. One estimate was 2,500 miles

Let us consider John 2:11 This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory. And his disciples believed in him. 12 After this he went down to Capernaum, with his mother and his brothers[b] and his disciples, and they stayed there for a few days.).

Cana to Capernaum is how far? Around 16 miles if you are a bird.



John 2:13. The Passover of the Jews was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

How far? 80 miles, don't know the routing.

<u>Jesus Christ was familiar with our griefs and struggles, Hebrew 2:17</u> Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. 18 For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.

<u>Jesus Christ is homeless -Luke 9:57-58.</u> 57 As they were going along the road, someone said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go." 58 And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head."
